

## Why do we need to know the history of abortion laws?

Pro-Choice movement is moving very fast to push for pro-abortion laws since Roe v Wade was overturned in June 2022.

Pending Abortion Bills aim to **drastically** change current abortion laws on Guam:

Anyone can do an abortion, any time and any place, without restrictions, limitations, and accountability.

Any delay or hindrance of an abortion may result in prosecution and or civil suits.

#### **Current Law on Guam**

- Abortion is legal on Guam!
  - Up to 13 weeks
  - Up to 26 weeks if a doctor determines grave child defect(s) and or major health risks to mother.
  - After 26 weeks, still possible with doctor's determination...
- Doctors are legally bound to report any partial abortion and complete abortions.
  - Most doctors choose NOT to perform abortions due to the stigma and familial ties
    - Known fact that abortions still take place without reporting...

## On the chopping block

- Reporting requirements from doctors
- Women's Reproduction Information Act (2012)
- In-person consultation and informed consent
- Parental consent

#### Making a comeback in legislation bills... (wording used in proposed bills)

- Partial birth abortion
- Abortion up to birth



2023 **Proposed** pro-abortion bills will be presented on Guam Legislature floor within the next few weeks

### Lawsuit involving PL 20-134 (Belle Arriola's Law)

- Bans abortion with few exceptions
- Referendum for people to vote and decide abortion on Guam
- Deemed unconstitutional
  - Injunction
- Dormant for 30 years
- 2022 Dobbs v. Jackson
- 2023 AG Moylan seeks to revive

Proposed Pro-Abortion Bills

- Bills 106-37 with referendum
- <u>Bill 111-37 without</u> referendum

### Proposed Bill 106-37 (April 28, 2023)

#### **Summary of Comments:**

- Proposes new abortion law- wiping out current law
- Language is misleading...
  - Woke language: "Pregnant People"
- Severability Clause
- Health Care Provider definition— Anyone can do an abortion
- Uses the same wording as the <u>Women's Health Protection Act of 2022</u>,
  - Refer to Handout
- Wording on the referendum is misleading:
  - Shall the Reproduction Health Act (aka Women's Health Protection Act (2023))
  - If you vote yes, the entire abortion law will be replaced
  - No discussion on if you vote "no"

#### Consequences of Bill 106-37

- Completely removes restrictions and rewrites all the abortion laws of Guam...
- Partial birth abortion is ALLOWED/ parental consent is gone...
- Abortion up to birth is legal....
- Don't have to be a doctor at any location....
- No reporting requirements.
- No follow up care...
- No counseling.... Free for all!
- No health safety regulations....
- Prosecution and or civil suits may result for any hindrance of an abortion.
- Praying outside an abortion clinic becomes a criminal offense
- Praying in public with an Anti-Abortion sign could be considered criminal and a civil lawsuit can also be brought against you

### Bill 111-37

#### Comments on this bill:

- Mirrors <u>106-37</u> except that it does not include the Referendum
- Comments is the same as for the bill No. <u>106-37</u>, excluding the referendum comments.

#### Lawsuit involving - Rado & Kaneshiro vs GovGuam

- Guam PL 31-235- The Women's Reproductive
   Health Information Act of 2012
  - Informed Consent
  - In-person requirement
- 9th Court Ruled with Opinion (08/01/2023)
- 9th Circuit Judges ruled that the

In-Person Requirement had to be met

This Opinion STOPPED Telemedicine Abortion!!! Effective end of August 2023

Proposed Pro-Abortion Bills

• <u>Bill 162-37</u> (08/08/23)

#### Bill 162-37 (introduced August 8, 2023)

- Amends the <u>PL 31-235- The Women's Reproductive Health</u> Information Act of 2012
  - Removing all in-person requirements
- Allows for telemedicine
- Proposes to increase sex education with emphasis on contraception and accessibility to contraception in public schools.
  - May require condoms and birth control pills to be made available in schools
- Misleading language "Caring for women and babies in the womb" Bill says the opposite...

## Summary of Proposed bills that are challenging Guam's current law...

- Bill 106-37 with referendum
  (Proposed on April 28, 2023)
- Bill 111-37 without referendum (Proposed on May 03, 2023)
- Bill 162-37 (Proposed on August 08, 2023)

- Abortion will be allowed anytime, anywhere, and may be done by anyone
- Any delays in abortion, may result in prosecution from AG and or civil suits
- No limitations/ No requirements
- No accountability
